 - **Visitation Supervisor** - We train folks to supervise court ordered visits between parents and children. Plan to take observation notes in order to write a report that will be forwarded to a Family Court Judge for long term decision making as it relates to custody/parenting time. This is an important role helping families feel welcome as they work through difficult situations.
